Subject: Final report re future planning

In the congregation's Feb 2024 Annual Meeting, a small committee (Betty & Brad) was formed to examine ideas for the future, recognizing the pattern of recurring deficits and declining membership.

After the arrival of our new Minister and new Director of Music, we held two focus groups in November 2024. In both sessions we recognized the things we did pre-pandemic, the things we're doing now that continue to support our work and mission in our community, and we brainstormed things we might undertake that would allow the congregation to continue to flourish. There was some overlap of ideas between the two sessions, and a consolidated list of over 30 items was developed, and posted on the pastoral charge's website.

Through December and January, we have been refining that list with the assistance of Rev Ian Wilgus, Rev Torri Mullin, Congregational Growth Animator for Eastern Ontario and Rev Roger Janes, Stewardship Resource Minister for our region.

The attached resulting focus areas, goals and initiatives were endorsed by Seagrave's Committee of Stewards in their January 2025 meeting with the provision that exact timing and responsibility for each item would be considered if the congregation accepted these recommendations.

We are hereby submitting them to you for discussion and approval in the Feb 19, 2025 Annual Meeting of the congregation.
